## Mobile Case Management Bringing Benefits to DCFS

DCFS has been using mobile technology for over a year and the new integrated solution is showing impressive results, including the ability to now complete critical tasks in hours rather than weeks. The mobile app is deployed to nearly 1,000 DCFS front line investigators, caseworkers and supervisors. As shared by Director Sheldon *"The mobile app technology that*"

we have incorporated into our child welfare system has increased productivity. Case notes are now more accurate and only have to be written one time. Now background information, important emails and notes are accessible to the social workers while they are in the field. All of this means we can serve our children in a better, faster, more efficient way." Future plans include rolling out the app to private agency caseworkers and the continued addition of new features as requested by the caseworkers.
