

National Cybersecurity Awareness Month (NCSAM)





Training Our Best Line of Defense

Introduced by DoIT and passed by the Illinois House, H.B. 2371 was signed by the Governor on August and requires state employees to undergo annual cybersecurity training.

DoIT will administer the on-line training that will include information to help employees detect phishing scams, prevent spyware infections and identity theft, and respond to data breaches. DoIT will modify the training to keep up with the ever-evolving subversive cyber activity.
