Innovation Incubator 2 (i2) at Work at DCEO

The Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO), in support of the Business and Workforce Cluster's Innovation Incubator (i2) project, has dramatically improved the way that raw data is analyzed using the Microsoft Power BI visualization tool. The new visualizations improve

DCEO's ability to demonstrate Illinois' strengths, such as in workforce, to potential clients. This new approach also reduced the manual processing involved with producing and analyzing reports.

DFPR Releases Portal for Online Real Estate Licensure

The Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (DFPR) takes yet another step forward in modernizing state government services. DFPR launched online licensure for real estate professionals through a recently announced portal. Replacing a manual system of mailing documents and payments that formerly took up to four weeks, licensee transactions now happen within days.

There are 85,000 real estate brokerage licensees in Illinois and DFPR processed 9,300 applications last year. The new system availability rounds out the list of automated systems supporting Real Estate Brokers in Illinois.
