65	Section 400	0.200 Training to be Provided by Department of Innovation and Technology

67	a)	Every employee shall annually undergo training by the Department of Innovation
68		and Technology concerning cybersecurity. (Section 25(b) of the Act).
69		
70	b)	The training shall include, but not be limited to, detecting phishing scams,
71		preventing spyware infections and identity theft, and preventing and responding
72		to data breaches. (Section 25(b) of the Act).
73		
74	c)	DoIT shall provide access to electronic-based, in-person, or paper-based
75		cybersecurity training, with reasonable efforts made to provide training in the
76		format requested to accommodate the needs of the employee and his or her
77		employing agency.

79		1) All employees are encouraged to complete cybersecurity training through
80		electronic means.

82		2) In-person training may include a web conference service component that,
83		if an employee attended online, would satisfy the training requirement as
84		though attended live in person.
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86	d)	DoIT shall establish a minimum of two training periods per year.
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88	e)	DoIT shall provide notice of tentative training dates at least 60 calendar days prior

95		cybersecurity training shall designate an internal contact to monitor and track
96		compliance with the cybersecurity training requirements.
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98	b)	The agency, board or commission shall promptly notify DoIT of its selection,
99		including contact information for that Designated Contact. This information shall
100		be submitted at security.training@illinois.gov.
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102	c)	To facilitate delivery of training materials, each agency, board and commission
103		with employees required to complete annual cybersecurity training shall maintain
104		a list identifying each employee who is required to complete annual cybersecurity
105		training. The Designated Contact shall notify DoIT of the number of employees in
106		its agency required to complete cybersecurity training.
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108	d)	Upkeep of the employee list referenced in subsection (a) is the sole responsibility
