On Saturday, October 1, the IL ACTS ERP Program launched SAP in our 4 pilot agencies (IDES, EPA, DVA, and IOC) after months of tireless work from agency and State staff members to make it successful. We are proud to have achieved this milestone in our ERP program and want to thank every person who has contributed to the success so far for the dedication and commitment shown. This is a huge step forward for technology at the State and we want to congratulate everyone on this achievement.

What has happened over the past few weeks?

We've made tremendous progress over the past nine weeks - so far, roughly 180 users have logged in to SAP, over 2,000 payment vouchers have been accepted by SAMS resulting in over \$100 million in disbursements, and close to \$50 million in state assets are being tracked in SAP. As the IL ACTS Program continues we will deploy SAP to other agencies in the State and the benefits will continue to multiply.

During this time, many of the State and Deloitte ERP Program team members were available to support each of the pilot agencies. Often on-site with the agencies, these team members provided significant technical (and at times emotional) support to agency users new to SAP. As issues arose, the teams assisted users and guided them to additional training materials available on the ERP website. Working closely with the agencies during this time has also enabled the ERP Program team to identify future enhancements to the system.

What happened over the Go Live weekend?

On Saturday October 1, our ERP Program team members met the agency staff at their respective locations and began processing transactions in SAP. Any issues experienced were called in or sent in online to the DoIT Help Desk. The Help Desk assigned all issues to the ERP Command Center and a team of State and Deloitte staff worked to resolved them. A big shout out to Liz McComb, IT Service Desk Manager and the entire Help Desk team for providing excellent customer service during the entire post go live timeframe.

Like any major system implementation, this project has brought its own unique blend of challenges and opportunities. As a market leader in Enterprise Solutions, SAP will enable the State of Illinois to adopt best practices in all areas of financial and human capital management. The value of an ERP solution lies in its enterprise-wide integration - this helps achieve a greater focus on analytics, better decision making, robust and accurate business information, and improved financial reporting. This will become more visible as we progress past go live.

We will continue to work with all the agencies to ensure their users can continue to successfully use the system. Please reach out to us with any thoughts or comments and sincere thanks to everyone's hard work!

Cluster 1A, BIOC/DOR/IEMA now in Development

We're now preparing for Cluster 1A to go live with ERP on April 1, 2017! The following agencies are part of Cluster 1A - Office of the Governor (GOV), Lt. Governor's Office (LTG), Capital Development Board (CDB), Governor's Office of Management and Budget (GOMB), Procurement Policy Board (PPB), Civil Services Commission (CSC), Historic Preservation Agency (HPA), and Inspector General's Office (OIG).

The Illinois Office of the Comptroller (BIOC), Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA), and the Department of Revenue (DOR) are preparing to go-live with ERP on July 1, 2017.

Over the next few weeks and months, users in these agencies will interact with several groups within the ERP program team to help them get ready for the launch. Based on feedback received from the Pilot implementation, the team has modified change management activities and approach to training for future clusters. Below is a general overview of activities, both from a change management perspective and a development perspective.

Overview of cluster distribution

Agencies included in future releases can focus on preparing for the data conversion process, i.e., preparing, collecting, cleaning and knowing their data for the conversion process.

Data cleansing (also known as data cleaning or data scrubbing) is the process of detecting and correcting (and / or removing) inaccurate records from a record set, database table or business file. The process refers to identifying incomplete, incorrect, inaccurate, irrelevant, etc. parts of the data and then replacing, modifying, or deleting "bad data" to ensure that your agency's master file data as well as transactional data is "clean". This process is used in database systems, file management systems and excel-based data storage solutions.

It's important to identify the correct data and business subject matter experts within your agency to own and work closely with the ERP team around data cleansing. This is a key success factor to the overall success of the conversion process as well as to the ERP implementation. Keep this in mind as well; *people are the key!*
